Subject: Harmonized Motorcycle Technician program: removal of Harmonized Level 4

(HL4) Standardized Level Exam (SLE)

Effective Date: April 1, 2022

> Note: Although this change will be reflected in the Harmonized Motorcycle Technician program, which will be implemented April 1, 2022, technical training for HL4 is not

phased in until April 1, 2025.

Summary of Change:

The Motorcycle Technician HL4 SLE will be removed from the apprenticeship pathway

and will **not** be a completion requirement for the **harmonized** program.

The Motorcycle and Power Equipment Technician (MPET) Current Level 4 (CL4) SLE will continue to be a completion requirement of the current program until CL4 phases

out on April 1, 2025.

Details: During consultation with external partners, it was agreed that the HL4 SLE will be

removed for the following reasons:

- Generally, trades in BC do not have an SLE in the last level of technical training.
- At the end of Level 4, apprentices currently have to prepare for two exams:
 - o The Level 4 SLE
 - The Interprovincial Red Seal Exam (IPSE)
- Removing the Level 4 SLE will bring the Motorcycle apprenticeship pathway into alignment with other trades and will allow the apprentices to focus on preparing for the IPSE.
