Summary of Change: A revised Harmonized Carpenter Program Outline has been posted to the Carpenter [trade page](#) on the ITA website. Changes were made to the Harmonized Level 4 (HL4) Assessment Guideline Grading Sheet.

Rationale: An error was identified and corrected in the HL4 Assessment Guidelines Grading Sheet. There were no achievement criteria associated with Line F in HL4; however, Line F received 5% practical weighting.

Details: **Line F:** 5% was removed from the practical weighting and redistributed as follows:

- **Line D:** 2% was added, bringing the practical weighting to 13%
- **Line I:** 3% was added, bringing the practical weighting to 12%.

The proposed revision was reviewed by the System Liaison, the Articulation Chair, and members of the review committee.

All apprentices who complete Level 4 of the Carpenter program with a FINAL level mark of 70% or greater will write the Interprovincial Red Seal examination as their final assessment.

ITA will enter the apprentices' Carpenter Interprovincial examination mark in ITADA. A minimum mark of 70% on the examination is required for a pass.
