Summary: Starting April 1st, 2024, apprentices are not required to write the SkilledTradesBC SLEs

until the exams are aligned with the 2024 Carpenter Program Outline and the 2024

British Columbia Building Code.

Details: Apprentices enrolled in the Carpenter program at all levels of technical training beginning

> on, or after, April 1st, 2024 are not required to write the SkilledTradesBC SLEs. For classes ending before the launch of the updated SLEs, the final mark for the level will be based

solely on in-school assessments.

Throughout 2024, the Carpenter program SLEs will be updated to align with the 2024 Carpenter Program Outline and with the 2024 British Columbia Building Code (BCBC). SLEs will be re-implemented as they are developed, and announced through an Official

Program Standards Notice (OPSN).

Please note that this does not impact the level challenge process or trade challenge

pathway.
