Summary of Change: The Electrician Level 1 (L1) Standardized Level Exam (SLE) is compliant to both the 2021 and 2024 Canadian Electrical Code (CEC). **Either the 2021 or 2024** Code Book may be used for the Electrician L1 SLE.

Details: The Electrician Level 1 SLE has been reviewed to ensure exam content is compliant to both the 2021 and 2024 CEC. Apprentices are required to bring a physical copy of the Code book to the exam session.

The Electrician Level 2 and Level 3 SLEs have **not yet** been reviewed for compliancy with the 2024 CEC. At this time, the 2018 and 2021 Code books remain in effect for the Electrician Level 2 and Level 3 SLEs. Once the Level 2 and Level 3 SLEs have been reviewed to determine compliancy with the 2024 CEC, an OPSN will be released.
