What is a skilled trade?

A skilled trade is a career that requires a particular skillset, knowledge base or ability. You see the evidence of skilled trades every day—when you walk into a building, drive down the road, go to a restaurant, or simply turn on a light. With nearly 90 trades to choose from in B.C., there's something for everyone.

What is a trade *apprenticeship*?

An apprenticeship is a combination of on-the-job training and classroom learning that leads to a skilled trades certification. You can be an apprentice during or after high school.

A typical apprenticeship is four years and each level will include 6-10 weeks of classroom training and 1500-1740 hours of on-the-job training.

After completing your work-based and classroom training hours and successfully passing your exam, you'll receive your Certificate of Qualification (CofQ) or Red Seal. Upon certification, you become a journeyperson with a strong foundation for a lifelong career and endless opportunities.
