EMBALMER AND FUNERAL DIRECTOR

Occupation Description

"Embalmer and Funeral Director" means a person who engages in the disinfection, preservation, preparation or restoration of human remains, negotiates or enters into funeral contracts, arranges, conducts or directs bereavement rites and ceremonies, arranges for the interment of human remains, and transfers human remains or directs or supervises the transfer of human remains.

Pathways to Certification

In BC, an individual can become certified as an Embalmer and Funeral Director by completing the Embalmer and Funeral Director program or by challenging the certification. Apprenticeship programs are for individuals who have an employer to sponsor them and challenge programs are for individuals who have extensive experience working in the occupation and wish to challenge the certification.

Youth can begin an apprenticeship in high school through the Youth Train in Trades or Youth Work in Trades programs. The Youth Work in Trades program is available for any trade if an employer is willing to sponsor the student. Trades offered through the Youth Train in Trades vary by region; contact your local school district to find out which technical training programs are being offered through the Youth Train in Trades program in your region.

Foundation programs, where available, provide adults and youth who do not have work experience nor employer sponsorship with an opportunity to gain the knowledge and skills needed to enter the occupation. Individuals who wish to enroll in a Foundation program must register directly with the training provider.

Recommended and/or Required Education

The following education is **recommended** for apprentices entering this occupation. These are not prerequisites, but rather a desired level of skill or knowledge that will contribute to success in the industry.

 Grade 12 completion (or equivalent from a recognized post-secondary institution) – Biology 12, Chemistry 12 and English 12

The following education is **required** prior to enrolment in the technical training for this occupation. It will be verified by the training provider upon enrolment.

• Level 1 Basic WCB Occupational First Aid course


SkilledTradesBC Registration


