Effective Date: January 1, 2023

Summary: Please be advised that the Harmonized RVST program will be implemented as of January 1, 2023, and the first harmonized intake will be Level 2 in October 2023. The Transition Plan is now posted on the [trade page](#).

Details: In July 2022, ITA Program Standards issued [OPSN-2022-014](#), which detailed the changes to the Recreation Vehicle Service Technician (RVST) Program as a result of the Harmonization Initiative and announced the implementation of a revised Program Outline, effective January 1, 2023. It also detailed changes to the amount of work-based training hours.

Between July and September 2022, ITA Program Standards consulted with the post-secondary training provider that delivers the RVST program. We evaluated several scenarios, and the transition plan outlined in the graphic below was identified as the best option. We have also ensured that there are options for all current apprentices to complete their apprenticeship.

ITA has begun a communication initiative that will ensure that all apprentices, employers, and other internal and external partners are aware of the changes to the program.
