Subject **Professional Cook ITA Assessment Guidelines**

Information It was brought to ITA's attention that the current Professional Cook program outlines for Levels 1, 2 and 3 do not have the Assessment Guidelines within the documents as do other trades' program outlines. As a result, the assessment guidelines chart is now included in each of the 3 levels of the Professional Cook program outlines. It is important to note that the inclusion of assessment guidelines does not constitute a change, rather the inclusion of the assessment guidelines in the program outlines ensures clarity for all training providers. Training Providers will continue to report one final in-school percentage score to ITA as an apprentice's in-school mark for the level.

Assessment Guidelines define the weighting of theory and practical marks by GAC to be used to calculate an apprentice's in-school mark for each level. The practical weighting is a reflection of performance on the achievement criteria for each level. The purpose of the assessment guidelines is to ensure that apprentice in-school marks are calculated in a comparable way across training providers.
