### BROADBAND NETWORK TECHNICIAN

### **Occupation Description**

A Broadband Network Technician installs, maintains and repairs cable and satellite telecommunication systems, including cable television, broadband internet and telephone services. Broadband Network Technicians work in the telecommunications industry, performing services on-site at client premises, in the distribution network or at the headend. On-site tasks include installations, troubleshooting, and repair of cable, internet or telephone systems. They also perform customer service and education tasks. Headend tasks include directing and routing broadband information to its destination and troubleshooting central problems.

## Pathways to Certification

In BC, an individual can become certified as a Broadband Network Technician by challenging the certification. Challenge programs are for individuals who have extensive experience working in the occupation and wish to challenge the certification.

### **Recommended Education**

The following education is **recommended** for challengers entering this occupation. These are not prerequisites, but rather a desired level of skill or knowledge that will contribute to success in the industry.

- Grade 12 is recommended
- Completion of a college program in electronics is recommended or

A combination of college, correspondence or industry courses related to electronics and electrical systems and on-the-job training is recommended

### SkilledTradesBC Registration

Those who wish to challenge the Broadband Network Technician certification must complete the Broadband Network Technician Challenge Application and submit it to SkilledTradesBC. Challenge applications are assessed for proof of workplace hours and scope of experience prior to acceptance of the individual into the Challenge pathway.




