Occupation Description

Petroleum Equipment Installers install, remove and upgrade fueling systems in the downstream petroleum sector of the oil and gas industry.

Pathways to Certification

In BC, an individual can become certified as a Petroleum Equipment Installer by challenging the certification. Challenge programs are for individuals who have extensive experience working in the occupation and wish to challenge the certification.

Recommended Education

The following education is **recommended** for challengers entering this occupation. These are not prerequisites, but rather a desired level of skill or knowledge that will contribute to success in the industry.

- Grade 10 or equivalent including: English 10, Math 10 and Science 10
- Preferred: Grade 12


Those who wish to challenge the Petroleum Equipment Installer certification must complete the Petroleum Equipment Installer Challenge Application and submit it to SkilledTradesBC. Challenge applications are assessed for proof of workplace hours and scope of experience prior to acceptance of the individual into the Challenge pathway.
