- Effective Date:** April 1, 2023
- Summary:** After April 1, 2023, please implement Harmonized Level 2 (HL2) with one day of training provider support to address gaps for apprentices who completed Current Level 1 (CL1). Information on the delivery of training provider support is provided below, and details of the gaps are available in the [Transition Plan](#).
- Standardized Level Exam:** **HL2 Standardized Level Exam (SLE):** The HL2 SLE is in development. An Official Program Standards Notification (OPSN) will be sent to announce its implementation. Until the SLE is launched, the class mark will serve as the final mark.
- Please note that the **CL2 SLE has been inactivated** and **cannot** be used with an HL2 class as the content is not aligned.
- Background:** On June 22, 2021, SkilledTradesBC Program Standards issued [OPSN 2021-006](#), which detailed the changes to the Motorcycle Technician program as a result of the Harmonization Initiative announcing the implementation of a revised Program Outline, effective April 1, 2022.
- Further to this, on November 17, 2021, SkilledTradesBC issued a Program Update announcing the [Transition Plan](#), summarized in the graphic on the following page.
