

SKILLEDTRADESBC BYLAW

Bylaw: Accredited Industry Training Programs

Bylaw Number: B1001

Definition:

An Accredited Training Program is a program that has been designated by the Minister responsible for the *SkilledTradesBC Act* by way of regulation as an accredited program and approved by the SkilledTradesBC Board of Directors. These programs follow national standards, include in-school and employment-based training, and employer attestation of competency. Successful completion of an Accredited Industry Training Program or successful certification challenge results in the issuance of a *Certificate of Qualification* with an Interprovincial Red Seal endorsement.

The apprenticeship training pathway to certification for programs listed in blue have been deactivated by (effective date), and certification is now only available through exam challenge.
